Buggy storage

Policy statement

Our aim at Moreland is to provide facilities for children and families for their convenience. We encourage parents and carers to follow the procedures for using the buggy area to ensure that the space is utilised as effectively and safely as possible. We encourage all children that live within walking distance of the nursery and who are developmentally able to do so, to walk to nursery because buggy parking space is limited. When children do need to use buggies, we recommend for parents/carers to use small foldable buggies as we cannot take responsibility for the safety expensive buggies in the event they get damaged or stolen.

Procedure

- Parents are asked to remove personal belongings and valuables from the buggies before storing them on site. Moreland nursery cannot accept any responsibility for items that may get lost or stolen.
- To fold the buggies to maximise the space to ensure that all buggies get storage space
- Use the allocated area for 0-3's to park the buggy first, the corridor is only to be used when outdoor area is full.
- Use weather protector over the buggy to protect from rain, as the wind has a tendency to blow the rain into the sheltered space
- Ensure buggies are not left in front of the fire exits because it is a legal requirement to keep all fire exits clear at all times.
- It is permitted to use the buggy parking area to store scooter but it may be advisable to label them with your child's name.
